Expected learning outcomes

After the study tour participants will:

- ® Obtain knowledge on prerequisites needed for formation and factors affecting development and functioning of clusters including HEI.
- Acquire skills related to clusters management, fundraising and organization of the common research activities, knowledge transfer and innovation scaling-up from HEI.
- ® Be able to understand how educational and research programmes could be tailored to support clusters and help them in problem solving and risk management.





® Gain competences for improved competitiveness of HEI within cluster organizations.

Objectives

The main objective of the study tours within UniClad project is make participants/beneficiaries stakeholders learn and explore about EU experience in general, and Austrian successful clusters case studies in particular, in the development of clusters and the participation/involvement of HEIs in this activity.

The study tour in Austria will attempt to transfer experience of different actors, application of researches results and implementation of innovations, etc. Further, activities intend to improve the knowledge and practical skills of the visitors and their organisations, and to integrate the experience gained from the visit into their everyday work.

Methodological approach

The methodology employed for the present study tour is based on action learning - open ended learning based on observation, dialogue, reflection, participation and visioning. Action learning is an experiential learning method in which participants learn by doing and then reflecting on what they have done.

The methodology foresees following activities: field visits, classroom work and post-study reporting period.

Learning consists of programmed instruction (introduction to the methodology by the coach), participative action (visits and interactions with actors), critical reflection and questioning which aims to enable participants to help each other to explore better the situations they face and information they gain during the filed visits.

Main steps include direct interaction with the key actor (cluster organization) and its member entities. During the field visits each actor (stakeholder) and place visited are considered as different learning arenas. Participants engagement is based on knowledge acquisition, peer and co-learning in groups, experimental learning and complex problem-solving.

During the activities in the classroom participants should reflect and on each part of their field activities in written and/or oral form to serve them as co-learning activity and UniClaD WP 2 Task 2.2 Study tour Austria





repository for final reporting. Group work, interactions, dialogue and individual reflection and visioning will result among other with **key success factors list** to be transferred to their home organizations.

Assessment will be performed in the form of self-evaluation and a study tour report.

Before the tour

- Sharing roles and responsibilities within the hosting institution staff (An overall Coordinator will be selected for the Visit, who will be the only contact to facilitate the flow of the activity. Coordinator will be supported by others)
- Identification of theme and selection of participants

- Preparation of study materials and organization of traveling for visits





The hotel is located near metro and train station Wien Nord Praterstern (Red Metro Line U1, S-Bahn Station) and can easily be reached by direct train S7 or REX7 from Airport Wien Schwechat within 25 minutes. There is just 6 minutes' walk from the S-Bahn train station Wien Nord Praterstern to your hotel.




When you arrive at the airport just follow the blue mark "S-Bahn", buy a ticket at the ticket machine right at the stop (2 zones since the airport is just out of the city border and central city zone, $4.80 \, \text{€}$). You can insert coins or bills (it will give change). Then take S7 or REX7 till station Praterstern.

Public transport in Vienna is easy. There is a dense network of trains, metros, buses and tramcars. There are some options e.g. one week ticket for 17,10 Euro or single tickets for 2.40 Euro (valid 90 minutes in all directions and unlimited changes of all transport facilities, just you may not go back the same way). Vienna, locations overview




